Two established visual artists, mother and daughter. Generations of two strong and beautiful women - connecting timelines in the history of their art and life. Their last joint exhibition was 2005 in Bornholm. And now, almost twenty years later - they are exhibiting their paintings together again on Åland.

Svetlana Vedernikova is a visual artist from Saint-Petersburg, where she graduated from the Repin's Academy of Arts back in the 70's. Her works can be found in many museum collections, including the St.Petersburg State Hermitage Museum, St.Petersburg State Russian Museum, Moscow Museum of Modern Art, The Klingspor Book Museum Offenbach, Germany.

Åland island is home for the visual artist Alexandra Trizna now, for 9 years. Her path as an artist and as a woman has interlaced Bornholm, Gothenburg, Stockholm with Saint-Petersburg as a starting point.

There she graduated from the Art Academy in 2005. Her career has touched many milestones, great and small, since.

This is a unique chance to encounter their artworks side by side, in the same place. The femininity in their paintings invites us to reflect on the eternal themes of fortitude, motherhood, the intricacy of life itself.
